

**IDAHO PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION**

**MINUTES OF DECISION MEETING**

**August 4, 2014 – 1:30 P.M.**

In attendance were Commissioners Mack Redford and Marsha Smith. Commissioner Smith called the meeting to order.
