

# IDAHO PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION

## MINUTES OF DECISION MEETING

March 23, 2015 – 1:30 P.M.

In attendance were Commissioners Paul Kjellander, Mack Redford and Kristine Raper. Commissioner Kjellander called the meeting to order.
