Page 9, footnote 1


READS:

“In Case No. AVU-G-11-03, the Commission approved a decrease of \$2.9 million in the Company’s DSM tariff rider, Schedule 191, instead of the \$2.8 million proposed by Avista. Order No. 32366. As a result, the net decrease in rates as a result of all natural gas service adjustments is slightly less than what was anticipated by the parties to this case when the Settlement and Stipulation was filed with the Commission.”

SHOULD READ:

“In Case No. AVU-G-11-03, the Commission approved a decrease of \$2.4 million in the Company’s DSM tariff rider, Schedule 191, instead of the \$2.9 million proposed by Avista. Order No. 32366. As a result, the net decrease in rates as a result of all natural gas service adjustments is slightly less than what was anticipated by the parties to this case when the Settlement and Stipulation was filed with the Commission.”
