Comment_description: Thank you for your time in Eagle last evening. Please consider these few additional comments.

1. Idaho Power needs to enter the 21st Century and be held accountable for their actions. They must provide data, (Disclosure) and answer questions in an honest & timely manner. They need to be more respectful to the patrons they service. They conduct their business in a manner that makes no good business sense. Ask me the price of a house... I tell you. Ask Id Power how much to bury wires in the ground, they can't or won't say, but assure us that we'll know someday...? That's UNACCEPTABLE!
2. I oppose the tall power poles aesthetically and because of their negative impact to my property values, and because of EMF & the potential health issues. It's just a matter of time before the 'proof' can no longer be disputed. It was the same with lead in paint, aesbestos in floor tile, cigarettes and second hand smoke... All are harmful.
3. I built my first home in Eagle in 1991. I was required to place ALL utilities underground then, and have been required to do so with two ensuing home purchases. Idaho Power should be held to the same higher standard mandated not only by Eagle's comprehensive plan, but by the mandates and trends of their industry and their peers.
4. YES, I AM WILLING TO PAY TO BURY HIGH POWER LINES. I also believe that ID Power and all Idaho citizens should share in the expense. Idaho Power rates are very low. They should be allowed to raise their rates RATIONALLY, creating an escrow account for all to draw from as their need for NEW or UPGRADED services might arise. Realizing that these monies would not appear magically overnight, and most likely not in Idaho Powers timeframe, I am still willing to pay my fair share.
