
Dear Mr. Kjellander,

I respectfully request that the Commission delay rendering a final decision on the Idaho Power / City of Eagle issue until we have had the opportunity to create a greater awareness of the issue among the residents of the city of Eagle. On October 17<sup>th</sup> we have a bulk mail piece being sent via US Postal Service Carrier Route to every address in Eagle. On this day we will also roll out Stop IdahoPower.com which will serve as an information source and public message board for residents of Eagle to express their concerns and discuss alternative solutions. We will also be placing yard signs by permission throughout Eagle to create additional awareness of the issue.

Idaho Power has not been a good neighbor. While we respect the need for continued expansion of power lines as our communities continue to grow, alternative installation solutions which address the health, property value and quality of life issues must be properly considered.

Awareness of the issue among residents is extremely minimal and Idaho Power's willingness to work with the city has been less than satisfactory. Please allow us additional time to create awareness and allow the residents of Eagle participate in this critical issue.
