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On April 14, 2006, Idaho Power Company filed an Application with the Commission seeking a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity for the construction of the Evander Andrews Power Plant. The Application also requests approval to rate base the prudent capital costs for the project and recover prudent fuel costs in the Company's Power Cost Adjustment mechanism. In Order No. 30038 the Commission issued a Notice of Application and set a deadline for intervention. On May 31, 2006, the Commission granted intervention to the Industrial Customers of Idaho Power (ICIP) and Mountain View Power, Inc. The parties have met twice for informal prehearing scheduling conferences in June and July.
