Perhaps it is obvious, but the primary cause for the need to increase transmission capability by a utility is the load, not generation. Generation has to follow load. Therefore, the ratepayers should bear the majority of the cost of transmission upgrade, as this arrangement does. I support this agreement because it may be a way to finance needed upgrades in Idaho Power's transmission system, which is looking woefully inadequate to bring in the power needed to supply a growing load. It seems no one disagrees with the statement that very little investment has been made in transmission over the last 30 years. And, compared to other utilities which have 500 kV lines, Idaho Power's 230 kV lines are looking pretty puny.
