On June 8, 2007, Idaho Power Company filed an Application for authority to increase the Company's rates for electric service by 10.35%. If approved, the Company's annual revenues would increase by \$63.9 million. On June 25, 2007, the Commission issued a Notice of Application and Intervention Deadline. Order No. 30346.

On October 1-3, 2007, the Commission Staff conducted public workshops for Idaho Power customers in Pocatello, Twin Falls and Boise, Idaho. At these workshops customers had an opportunity to hear from Commission Staff regarding the Company's Application to increase rates and to ask questions of Staff and representatives of the Company.

On October 19, 2007, the Commission issued Order No. 30456 granting the Company and Commission Staff's Joint Motion to Extend the Procedural Schedule in this case, and establishing a procedural schedule. In the Order the Commission scheduled the technical hearing in this matter to convene on <u>January 22-25, 2008 in the Commission Hearing Room, 472 West Washington Street, Boise, Idaho</u>. The purpose of the technical hearing is to allow the Company, intervenors and the Staff to introduce testimony and exhibits regarding the Company's Application to increase its rates for electric service.

The Commission will also convene three public hearings to provide opportunities for members of the public to testify regarding Idaho Power's Application.
