NOTICE OF RESCHEDULED PUBLIC HEARING

On June 8, 2007, Idaho Power Company filed an Application for authority to increase its rates an average of 10.35%. If approved the Company's revenues would increase by \$63.9 million. The Company requested that the proposed rate increase become effective on July 8, 2007.

On August 8, 2007, the Commission issued a Notice of Scheduling and Notice of Hearing, establishing October 19, 2007 as the deadline for Staff and Intervenors to file testimony, and setting December 10-13, 2007 as the technical hearing. On October 18, 2007, Idaho Power and Staff filed a Joint Motion to Extend the Procedural Schedule. On October 19, 2007, the Commission issued Order No. 30456 granting the Joint Motion to Extend the Procedural Schedule. Consequently, the technical hearing was scheduled to begin Tuesday, January 22, 2008.

On January 17, 2008, the Commission determined to convene the technical hearing on January 23, 2008, rather than January 22, 2008. The Commission has also determined to vacate the Boise public hearing scheduled for Wednesday, January 23, 2008.

YOU ARE HEREBY NOTIFIED that the Boise public hearing has been rescheduled to commence on <u>THURSDAY</u>, FEBRUARY 7, 2008, AT 7:00 P.M. IN THE IDAHO <u>PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION HEARING ROOM, 472 WEST WASHINGTON</u> <u>STREET, BOISE, IDAHO</u>. The public hearings scheduled for Chubbuck and Twin Falls will be held as scheduled. The purpose of the public hearings is to offer customers and members of the public an opportunity to offer sworn testimony regarding Idaho Power's Application to increase its rates for electric service.

YOU ARE FURTHER NOTIFIED that all hearings in this matter will be held in facilities meeting the accessibility requirements of the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA). Persons needing the help of a sign language interpreter or other assistance in order to participate in or to understand testimony and argument at a public hearing may ask the Commission to provide a sign language interpreter or other assistance at the hearing.
