On October 16, 2008, Idaho Power filed a Petition for Declaratory Order and Formal Complaint for Breach of Contract against Glenns Ferry Cogeneration Partners, LTD (Glenns Ferry). Idaho Power alleges that Glenns Ferry has permanently lost its host (Idaho Fresh-Pak) and Glenns Ferry's delivery of energy has been permanently curtailed. On October 21, 2008, a summons was issued by the Commission notifying Glenns Ferry that it had 21 days to respond to Idaho Power's complaint. On November 10, 2008, Glenns Ferry filed with the Commission a Motion to Dismiss for Lack of Subject Matter Jurisdiction.

On January 13, 2009, Idaho Power filed (1) a brief opposing Glenns Ferry's Motion to Dismiss and (2) a Request for Oral Argument on the limited issue of whether the Commission has subject matter jurisdiction over the complaint. Glenns Ferry did not oppose Idaho Power's motion for Oral Argument.

We find that oral argument may be helpful in clarifying the issues that have been raised by the parties in Glenns Ferry's Motion to Dismiss and responses thereto. Therefore, the Commission grants Idaho Power's request for oral argument on the limited issue of subject matter jurisdiction.

**NOTICE OF HEARING FOR ORAL ARGUMENT**




