My name is Harold Huyser.

We lived the last 58 yrs in Lincoln County. Had a Feedlot, crops and Dairy, with my wife and 3 sons.

I'm presently retired and my Sons Lease the operation.

You are the Public Utilities Commission Board. I am protesting any of these Increases, in Power rates.

My wife and I are living on a fixed income. It will make it more difficult to make end meet to have a Idaho Power increase. Our Power Bill was on a Level Pay plan. of \$128,00 of our Home. every month.

This rate increase will make it difficult for SENIOR CITIZENS TO pay their Power Bill. This increase is very untimely.

Cost of power is 15 to 20% for cost of production on Crops. Cost increase to Irrigation is DEVASATING. My Son raises lots of Hay and the price is down 50% from last year. All the other commodities 50% Lower this year.

EXAMPLE . Last year, 2008. Wheat was \$7.40. This year it \$4.00.

DAIRYMEN : are the Biggest Industry in the State Of Idaho. Price of Milk in 2008 was \$20.40. Price today is \$9.50. Cost of production is \$14.00 per 100 CWT. This is a terrific Lost. Losing about \$5.00 per 100 CWT. All other industies will be effected by this rate increase.

Business have Layed off many people and many has went clear our of Business

For Idaho Power. This is a good water year for power,
Generation Cost should be down.

You are asking for a Cost Increases that are covered by year
to Year. Expenses- Such as Meters.
