My only comment regarding this order is I'm not sure \$7.00 a month is enough incentive to get businesses on board. The business I manage has 4 big AC units at two of our locations (16,000 sq ft each). We are a schedule I09S and normally have over \$1,000 a month electric bill. I'm sure the peak shaving from our locations would far surpass that of a residential customer. So, I would believe a bigger incentive would be fair. It may be possible this pilot program is not intended for the size operation that we have. We would be very interested in participating in an AC cycling program but I believe a bigger incentive would be needed. If businesses will sign up for a \$7.00 a month credit I think that is great.
