NOTICE OF FILING

YOU ARE HEREBY NOTIFIED that on June 4, 2010, Idaho Power Company ("Idaho Power" or "Company") filed a revised tariff sheet for Schedule 54, the Fixed Cost Adjustment ("FCA").

YOU ARE FURTHER NOTIFIED that Idaho Power's filing contains updated values for the fixed cost per customer ("FCC") and fixed cost per energy ("FCE") to recognize Commission-approved charges in base rates that went into effect on June 1, 2010. The FCC and FCE do not affect the FCA rates approved by the Commission in Order No. 31081, but rather set the benchmark for the prospective year's deferral balances.

YOU ARE FURTHER NOTIFIED that Idaho Power's filing corresponds to an annual increase of \$20.61 and \$7.79 per residential and small commercial customer, respectively, and amounts to a net increase in authorized fixed costs of \$8.8 million over 2008 figures.

YOU ARE FURTHER NOTIFIED that the Company's proposed effective date of the updated values, June 1, 2010, has been suspended by the Commission to allow Commission Staff and interested parties additional time to review the filing.

NOTICE OF MODIFIED PROCEDURE

YOU ARE FURTHER NOTIFIED that the Commission has determined that the public interest may not require a formal hearing in this matter and will proceed under Modified Procedure pursuant to Rules 201 through 204 of the Idaho Public Utilities Commission's Rules of Procedure, IDAPA 31.01.01.201 through .204. The Commission notes that Modified

Procedure and written comments have proven to be an effective means for obtaining public input and participation.

YOU ARE FURTHER NOTIFIED that any person desiring to state a position on this Application may file a written comment in support or opposition with the Commission within thirty (30) days from the service date of this Notice. The comment must contain a statement of reasons supporting the comment. Persons desiring a hearing must specifically request a hearing in their written comments. YOU ARE FURTHER NOTIFIED that if no written comments or protests are received within the time limit set, the Commission will consider this matter on its merits and enter its Order without a formal hearing. If written comments are received within the time limit set, the Commission will consider them and, in its discretion, may set the same for formal hearing.

YOU ARE FURTHER NOTIFIED that the filing is available for public inspection during regular business hours at the Commission offices. The filing is also available on the Commission's web site at www.puc.idaho.gov by clicking on "File Room" and then "Electric Cases."






ORDER


