### Petition for Clarification

I have the following questions concerning the above decision.

1. As a Net Metering residential Idaho Power Company (IPCo.) customer with an accumulated dollar credit of around \$200. (+-), what is the status of this credit on 1 January 2014? Does the accumulated credit vanish as originally proposed by Idaho Power or is it converted back into "surplus" kWhs that could be used after the 1 January 2014 date in accordance with IPUC Order No. 32846?
2. If the dollar credit is carried forward after 1 January can it be used to cover the IPCo. monthly administrative and/or any additional kWh costs until extinguished?
3. If the earned dollar credit is not carried over as a (usable) part of my account, what is the official cut off date for any net metering customer to request a credit payment from IPCo.?

What is the correct chronology of "management actions", as they pertain to the above case, from now until January 2, 2014? This should answer the above questions.
