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On December 14, 2016, Idaho Power Company filed a prudency Application for expenditures of \$220,845,830 in Hells Canyon Complex (HCC) relicensing costs for inclusion in customer rates at a later date. The Company is not requesting an adjustment to customer rates at this time.

On January 4, 2017, the Commission issued a Notice of Application and Order setting an intervention deadline of January 25, 2017, and directing Staff to develop a procedural schedule for the processing of this matter. The Idaho Irrigation Pumpers Association and Industrial Customers of Idaho Power filed timely intervention. A Notice of Parties was issued on February 14, 2017. Staff proposed that this matter be processed by Modified Procedure. The parties have agreed upon a schedule to process this case.

With this Order, we adopt the proposed schedule.
