On May 7, 2018, the Commission ordered this case to be processed by Modified Procedure, Rules 201-204 (IDAPA 31.01.01.201-.204), and set a June 21, 2018 comment deadline and a July 5, 2018 reply deadline. *See* Order No. 34056. Commission Staff has now advised the Commission that all parties—including petitioner Idaho Department of Administration, Commission Staff, and sole intervenor Idaho Power Company—would like the Commission to extend the comment deadline to July 5, 2018 and the reply deadline to July 19, 2018, to facilitate discovery. *See* Staff Memorandum dated May 25, 2018.
