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



CAPAI is a non-profit corporation consisting of six community action agencies serving every county in Idaho and also includes, among others, the statewide Idaho Migrant Council and fights the causes and conditions of poverty through building the capacity and effectiveness of its members who have a direct and substantial interest in this proceeding. These causes and conditions of poverty include high utility costs for PacifiCorp's low income rate payers. Low income families pay a higher percentage of their income for utility expenses than those in other economic categories. Consequently, CAPAI has a direct and substantial interest in this proceeding.

4. CAPAI intends to participate in this proceeding as a party and introduce testimony and exhibits, cross-examine other witnesses, engage in oral argument, file comments, and otherwise fully participate as a party.
