Please describe your question or comment briefly:
Monsanto has competitively operated their elemental phosphorus facility in Soda Springs, Idaho for over 55 years. A key factor to Monsanto's longevity has been fair and equitably priced large industrial power rates. PacifiCorp - Rocky Mountain Power's unprecedented back-to-back power rate increases (17% increase in 2006 and the proposed 33% increase in 2007) in putting Monsanto's ability to remain globally competitive at-risk. I strongly urge the Idaho PUC to temper PacifiCorp - Rocky Mountain Power's proposed power rate increase to a more reasonable and globally competitive rate.
