Once again we as customers are being asked to pay for another power program to conserve power at the same time we are looking at a general rate case. I feel until the general rate case is resolved the DSM case should be put on hold. Rocky Mountain power just received a energy fuel cost adjustment this year and now they want a two percent DSM increase in rates to be followed by a average fourteen percent rate increase in a general rate case. This looks like piecemeal rate making to me why don't we just settle this case in the general rate case or as I suggested hold this case until the general rate case is resolved.
