Please describe your comment briefly:

I believe the requested rate increase of 15.6% for time of use residential users is excessive. We have participated in the time of use program for over 20 years. We were told by the utility that this would cut down on the need for more generation capacity. We have followed this program very carefully and use nearly 70% of our power off peak. This has not been easy. We have suffered through cold temperatures in the house and not used our electric furnace until the off peak times. We do all laundry on the weekends, and take showers before the off peak ends early in the morning. Now the utility wants to reward our efforts by raising our rates more than twice that of other residential users. Please adjust the rate increase request for time of use residential downward so that it is no more than for other residential users.
