Please describe your comment briefly:

My wife and I are serving a Mormon Mission in Salt Lake but we maintain our permanent home in Dayton, Idaho and will return there on Dec. 29, 2010. I think it is really bad to have such high rate increase of this magnitude even be proposed. We live mostly on Social Security and had no raise last year and none coming this year. Our home is electric heat and so it affects us more than some.

It seems prepostrous to be in severe economic downturn and then have the power company ask for unreasonable rate increase. Please get some sense talked into them. A small raise of 2 or 3 percent could be tolerated, but 8% on up is just not acceptable.
