TECHNICAL HEARING

On March 1, 2013, PacifiCorp dba Rocky Mountain Power ("Rocky Mountain") filed an Application requesting that the Commission open a case "to identify interested parties that would like to participate [in] settlement discussions" regarding alternatives to the Company filing a general rate case.

On March 12, 2013, the Commission issued a Notice of Application and Intervention Deadline directing Staff counsel to convene an informal prehearing conference so that the parties may discuss a schedule for settlement conference and other preliminary matters. Order No. 32761 at 3.

On April 19, 2013 and May 2, 2013, representatives of Rocky Mountain, Staff, Monsanto, IIPA, ICL, SRA, PIIC, and CAPAI met at the Commission offices and participated in informal settlement discussions.

On June 3, 2013, the Company filed a Stipulated Settlement Agreement ("Stipulation") signed by all of the parties, except CAPAI, that proposes, in lieu of a general rate case filing by the Company, to implement a two-year rate plan beginning on January 1, 2014. On June 19, 2013, the Commission issued a Notice of Proposed Settlement, Notice of Schedule, and Notice of Public Hearings. *See* Order No. 32831.
