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On July 3, 2017, Rocky Mountain Power applied for a certificate of public convenience and necessity (CPCN) to construct or acquire four new wind projects with a total combined capacity of 860 megawatts. The Company also requested CPCNs for several transmission facilities, portions of which are associated with the Company's Gateway West transmission project. The Company also requested approval of binding ratemaking treatment for the investment in the combined projects, in accordance with Idaho Code § 61-541. The Company has claimed that the projects will provide significant economic benefits for the Company's customers.

The Commission will conduct a telephonic hearing, as described below. The purpose of the public hearing is to take testimony from customers and other interested members of the public. Testimony will be made part of the Commission's formal record.
