

If granted, Intermountain Gas' proposed PGA would raise an additional \$61 million in revenue, all of which must go toward recovering expenses related to purchasing gas for its Idaho customers.

Is there or has there ever been an intent by the PUC to audit and review the business practices of Intermountain Gas ?

You proclaimed in ORDER NO. 29199 that "Staff further found that the Company has since taken steps to minimize the volatility of gas prices to customers". What went wrong ? Is it possible that Recommendations 1 through 4 were mere window dressing; that that there was never any intent to comply with or enforce Recommendations 5 and 6; that Recommendation #7 is now and has been nonexistent ?
