SEICAA's records indicate Intermountain Gas provided \$2500.00 in 2005 in cash donation (foundation) and approximately \$1500.00 in donated company prizes and time to the tournament. The Agency's financial records also show that between the period of 6/1/04 to 5/31/05 payments sent back to Intermountain Gas on behalf of the customer was \$4683.00 from the Project Warmth account.
