NG hit record lows in 2012, and did rebound slightly earlier this year; however, supplies are adequate, drilling has increased, new deposit are being discovered in Utah, Colorado, and Wyoming. The current trend in prices is downward back toward 3.00 per mmbtu and currently 3.35. I do not think a rate increase is justified as the trend is down, supplies are more than adequate, supplies are increasing, the sources are in neighboring states.
