
Dear Sir or Madam:

Charter Fiberlink ID - CCVII, LLC ("Charter") hereby respectfully requests the withdrawal of the above-referenced Application from further consideration by the Idaho Public Utilities Commission (the "Commission"). As of the date of this letter, Charter has not yet commenced the provision of telecommunications services in Idaho. As such, no customers will be affected by the action requested by Charter herein.

Charter understands from discussions with Ms. Carolee Hall of the Commission's Staff that its initial service offerings, consisting of private line voice and data services, are not subject to regulation by the Commission as they qualify as Data Local Exchange Carrier (DLEC) services. Accordingly, Charter does not need certification as requested in the Application to provision its initial services in Idaho.
