**AMENDMENT ONE TO THE
INTERCONNECTION AND TRAFFIC INTERCHANGE AGREEMENT FOR
CELLULAR AND OTHER TWO-WAY MOBILE RADIO SERVICES**

This Amendment One to the Interconnection and Traffic Interchange Agreement for Cellular and Other Two-Way Mobile Radio Services (the "Agreement") between Citizens Telecommunications Company of Idaho, ("Frontier") and the Verizon Wireless entities listed on the signature page of this Amendment (collectively "Carrier") is made this 1st day of August, 2009. Frontier and Carrier are referred to herein collectively as the "Parties".

Frontier and Carrier entered into the Agreement on October 9, 2007

Carrier has requested to include additional Verizon Wireless entities not previously listed as a Party to the Agreement.

Frontier and Carrier desire to amend this Agreement.

In consideration to the mutual promises and covenants contained herein, and for other good and valuable consideration, the Parties agree as follows:

1. Implement a new traffic factor for all Service Attachments incorporated within the Agreement under Section 1.5 to the following:

Mobile-to-Land 70%
Land-to-Mobile 30%

2. Implement a new traffic factor for all Service Attachments incorporated within the Agreement under Section 2.2 to the following:

Carrier shall pay 70% of the recurring and non-recurring two-way facility as noted in Section 4.2.2 of the Agreement. Citizens shall pay 30% of the recurring and non-recurring two-way facility as noted in Section 4.2.2 of the Agreement.

3. Implement a new traffic factor for all Service Attachments incorporated within the Agreement under Section 3.1 to the following:

Carrier shall assume 70% ownership of the assumed minutes and Frontier shall assume 30% ownership of the assumed minutes (i.e., the ration of Mobile-to-Land traffic is 70/30) for those Frontier End Offices identified in writing to Carrier.

All other terms and conditions of the Agreement will remain in full force and effect.


