Dear Mrs. Jewell:

Electric Lightwave seeks the Commission's approval for the code assignment of two consecutive 1,000 blocks (NXX-X blocks) from Idaho's 208 Area Code for use by Ada County. This request is consistent with both the current and near-term business needs of the County as outlined in the attached letter from Doug Heikkila, Ada County Director of Information Technology.

This request will not overly burden the existing number resources of Idaho. Today, Electric Lightwave has a total of 47,000 numbers, of which, 88 percent are assigned to customers. The addition of the requested blocks will increase Electric Lightwave's utilization to 89 percent.

Electric Lightwave's initial request to Neustar, the Pooling Administrator, was denied due to lack of a State Waiver. (See attached request and subsequent denial notice). To expedite the release of the requested codes, Electric Lightwave requests that the Commission send a letter to the Pooling Administrator stating support for the code assignment. Dear Mr. Robins:

Based on information received from your Boise ELI Office, it appears that a formal request is required for Ada County to ask for a specific DID range from ELI, our current dial tone provider. Please consider this our formal request.

We are limited on which extension numbers are compatible with our current internal dialing plan and system programming that has been in effect for over two years. We are now planning to extend our new system to employees located at the Public Safety Complex at 7200 Barrister, the Juvenile Detention Center at 6300 Denton Street and the future Field Services Bldg. in Meridian. These county locations currently, or will in the future, house Boise City and Ada County employees whose jobs involve immediate response to emergency situations throughout Ada County on a daily basis. This type of job duty makes the ability to communicate with these employees quickly and simply via a 4-digit extension a requirement.

We originally requested 2,000 new DID numbers from ELI to handle growth. Most of the numbers offered conflict with our current numbering plan, either because we already have extensions in the same range (the last four digits of the DID number) or because the extension would start with a 9 (9XXX series), which conflicts with our outside line access code. We also have problems with extensions that would begin with a "0". Thus, we are somewhat limited on what fits within our current number scheme.

We believe the best course of action for both the County and ELI is our formal request for a consecutive number block in the range of 208-XXX-3000 through 208-XXX-4999. Since many of the extension ranges not starting with a 3 or a 4 are currently being used by other Ada County Departments, we must otherwise be extremely selective in which number blocks will work - we have already accepted (and exhausted) most of the workable DID extension blocks in the 287 office code prefix as part of earlier requests. Thus, we expect the new numbers will be in a new/separate office code; however, we request all 2,000 DID number begin with the same office code to reduce confusion with the public.
