On January 29, 2009, iNetworks Group, Inc. (iNetworks) filed an Application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (CPCN) to provide resold local exchange and resold interexchange telecommunications services in the State of Idaho. The Company intends to provide resold local exchange, interexchange, dedicated point-to-point private line service and dedicated Internet access to business customers only.

NOTICE OF APPLICATION

YOU ARE HEREBY NOTIFIED that the Company intends to offer service throughout all exchanges currently served by Citizens, Qwest and Verizon. The Company asserts that it is currently in negotiations to complete interconnection agreements.

YOU ARE FURTHER NOTIFIED that the Company believes that granting its Application for a CPCN will further the public interest by expanding the availability of competitive telecommunications services in the State of Idaho. The Company maintains that it will provide Idaho customers with access to new technologies and service choices.

YOU ARE FURTHER NOTIFIED that the Company states that it possesses the requisite financial, managerial, and technical capacities to provide the proposed services. The Company does not intend to collect deposits or require advance payments from customers and, therefore, requests a waiver of the Commission's escrow account/security bond requirement.

NOTICE OF MODIFIED PROCEDURE

YOU ARE FURTHER NOTIFIED that the Commission has preliminarily determined that the public interest may not require a formal hearing in this matter and will proceed under Modified Procedure pursuant to the Commission's Rules of Procedure 201 through 204, IDAPA 31.01.01.201 through .204. written comments have proven to be an effective means for obtaining public input and participation.

YOU ARE FURTHER NOTIFIED that any person desiring to state a position on this Application may file a written comment in support or opposition with the Commission within **twenty-one (21) days** from the service date of this Notice. The comment must contain a statement of reasons supporting the comment. Persons desiring a hearing must specifically request a hearing in their written comments. YOU ARE FURTHER NOTIFIED that the Application and supporting workpapers have been filed with the Commission and are available for public inspection during regular business hours at the Commission offices. The Application and other workpapers are also available on the Commission's Website at www.puc.idaho.gov by clicking on "File Room" and then "Telephone Cases."




ORDER


