YOU ARE HEREBY NOTIFIED that on January 16, 2007, Matrix, Inc. filed an Application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to provide facilities-based and resold local exchange telecommunications services within the State of Idaho. The Application states Matrix will provide these services through interconnection agreements and commercial wholesale agreements with Verizon Northwest Inc. and Qwest Corporation. Matrix anticipates it will begin providing service in the spring of 2007 and intends to deploy and maintain company-owned facilities only after customer saturation can support such deployment.

YOU ARE FURTHER NOTIFIED that Matrix has a Certificate of Incorporation from the State of Texas dated June 30, 1990 and a Certificate of Authority from the State of Idaho dated June 12, 1992. The Company's principal place of business is in Dallas, Texas. Matrix has provided financial information and the appropriate contact information for its registered agent for service of process within Idaho. The Company also filed a revised illustrative tariff on February 21, 2007 and affirms that it has reviewed all the Commission rules and agrees to comply with them.

YOU ARE FURTHER NOTIFIED that the Commission has determined that the public interest may not require a formal hearing in this matter and will proceed under Modified Procedure pursuant to Rules 201 through 204 of the Idaho Public Utilities Commission's Rules of Procedure, IDAPA 31.01.01.201-204. The Commission notes that Modified Procedure and written comments have proven to be an effective means for obtaining public input and participation.




