**SUBJECT:** MBC TELECOM, LLC APPLICATION FOR A CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY, CASE NO. MBC-T-09-01

On December 21, 2009, MBC Telecom, LLC filed an Application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (CPCN) to provide facilities-based and resold local exchange services in the State of Idaho. The Application states that the Company intends to offer local exchange and exchange access services, including origination and termination services, for retail and wholesale customers.

The Company seeks authority to provide telecommunications services in areas currently served by Qwest and Verizon. MBC intends to use facilities purchased from other carriers and does not anticipate installing its own physical plant in Idaho. The Company's Application states that it will begin negotiations for interconnection agreements upon issuance of a CPCN by the Commission.


MBC is a limited liability company organized under the laws of Nevada. The Company is registered as a foreign corporation with Idaho's Secretary of State.
