
RE: Broadband Investment Tax Credit – Midvale Telephone Exchange for 2006 and 2007

- 1) Midvale Telephone Exchange is a provider of wholesale broadband telecommunications service, and other telecommunications services in Idaho.
- 2) During the calendar years 2006 and 2007, Midvale Telephone Exchange made certain investments that constitute "qualified broadband equipment" within the meaning of Section 63-3029(1)(3)(b), Idaho Code. Exhibit A-2006, and Exhibit B-2007, attached hereto, describe Midvale Telephone's qualified broadband equipment and contains the information and representation required by this Commission's Order No. 28784 in Case No. GNR-T-01-10.


