Hi Carolee -

It was nice talking with you last week. As I mentioned during our conversation, I am in need of a waiver or email approval from you that will allow us to temporarily have two LRNs, per switch, per Lata in order to transfer and migrate our ID resources from one OCN to another. We will only have two LRNs for a short period - just long enough to complete the transfer and migration. Below is a description of our project and why we need two LRNs in order to complete our migration.

36Onetworks was acquired by Zayo Group (which also owns Onvoy) in December 2011. Onvoy has been using the legacy 36Onetworks (Zayo) OCN 785D. Onvoy is working on a large corporate roll up project that, once complete, will allow us to migrate all of the resources currently assigned to the legacy 36Onetworks OCNs to the Onvoy OCNs, and we will no longer use the legacy 36Onetworks (Zayo) OCNs. We plan to have everything in place and complete by July 1, 2014. In order to do this without impeding our ability to continue to do business

throughout the process, we need to establish initial block and LRN under the Onvoy OCN (898G) using our current switches (BOISID374MD and CRALIDXXX7X). Once established, we will begin the process of transferring all of our current resources under the legacy 360networks (Zayo) OCN to the Onvoy OCN, remove the old LRN and will be in compliance with the guidelines that allow for only one LRN per switch, per Lata.

We have followed the process and submitted our request to pooling and received our rejection (attached). With your approval, we can resubmit our request to pooling and get the necessary code and block assignments (two blocks will be retained in each code, sixteen blocks will be returned to pooling), create the new LRN and proceed with the transfer and migration of our ID resources in order to complete our project. Our project also includes reviewing our needs and resources and return all unnecessary resources to pooling so as to not burden the pooling resources.

Please let me know if you have any questions or require additional information. Thank you in advance for your consideration.
