**RE: QWEST CORPORATION DBA CENTURYLINK QC'S EXTENSION OF
ALL CURRENT CENTURYLINK LOCAL SERVICES PLATFORM
(CLSP) AGREEMENTS FOR THE PERIOD OF JANUARY 1, 2014
THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2016.**

On January 10, 2014, Qwest Corporation dba CenturyLink QC (CenturyLink) submitted a letter to advise the Commission that CenturyLink had extended all of its current Legacy Qwest's CenturyLink Local Service Platform (CLSP) commercial agreements, which expired on December 31, 2013. These agreements begin on January 1, 2014 and continue through December 31, 2016. Upon expiration, the agreements will continue on a month-to-month basis until terminated by either Party, with 90 days prior written notice. (QWE-T-09-13); Matrix-Excel fka Comtel (QWE-T-02-12); Matric-VarTec fka Comtel (QWE-T-02-01); MCImetro Access (QWE-T-06-24); McLeod (QWE-T-00-07); Metropolitan (QWE-T-05-05); New Horizons (QWE-T-13-01); OrbitCom (QWE-T-04-13); PiperTel (QWE-T-05-06); Praxis (QWE-T-12-08); Prime Time Ventures (QWE-T-05-08); QuantumShift-VCom (QWE-T-08-09); Spectrotel (QWE-T-12-03); and TNCI (QWE-T-05-09).
