YOU ARE HEREBY NOTIFIED that on September 29, 2011, Time Warner Cable Information Services (Idaho), LLC (“TWCIS” or “Company”) filed an Application for a Certification as a wholesale communications provider in Idaho pursuant to Commission Order No. 32277 in Case No. GNR-T-11-01, Commission Rule of Procedure 114 and Title 62 of the Idaho Code.

YOU ARE FURTHER NOTIFIED that TWCIS intends to offer intrastate telecommunications services for commercial and wholesale customers statewide. Such services may include point-to-point, private line, access and transport services.

YOU ARE FURTHER NOTIFIED that TWCIS has signed an interconnection agreement with Frontier Communications Northwest Inc. The Company acknowledges that, pursuant to Commission Rule of Procedure 114.08 and Commission Order No. 30425, non-paging telecommunications carriers with telephone numbering resources in Idaho shall be subject to numbering conservation measures, including mandatory 1,000-block pooling.

YOU ARE FURTHER NOTIFIED that TWCIS agrees to comply with all of the Commission’s rules and procedures.

NOTICE OF MODIFIED PROCEDURE

YOU ARE FURTHER NOTIFIED that the Commission has determined that the public interest may not require a formal hearing in this matter and will proceed under Modified Procedure pursuant to Rules 201 through 204 of the Idaho Public Utilities Commission’s Rules of Procedure, IDAPA 31.01.01.201 through .204. The Commission notes that Modified Procedure and written comments have proven to be an effective means for obtaining public input and participation.

YOU ARE FURTHER NOTIFIED that the Application has been filed with the Commission and is available for public inspection during regular business hours at the Commission offices. The Application is also available on the Commission's web site at www.puc.idaho.gov by clicking on "File Room" and then "Telephone Cases."

YOU ARE FURTHER NOTIFIED that all proceedings in this case will be held pursuant to the Commission's jurisdiction under Title 62 of the Idaho Code. The Commission

may enter any final Order consistent with its authority under Title 62 and Commission Rule of Procedure 114, IDAPA 31.01.01.114.

YOU ARE FURTHER NOTIFIED that all proceedings in this matter will be conducted pursuant to the Commission's Rules of Procedure, IDAPA 31.01.01.000 *et seq.*


ORDER


