YMax requests a certificate for all Idaho exchanges not exempt from competition.

The Company has a Certificate of Authority to do business in the State of Idaho issued by the Idaho Secretary of State on March 10, 2006. The Company also filed an illustrative tariff (and revisions thereto on June 28, 2006).
