As for pressure dropping to 0 this could have created a backflow incident. The Owner/opperater did not notify my home regaring this matter which could have posed a health risk.

If a system is required to Chlorinate its water there is a bacteria in the water at times of testing . Then the water should maitain the residule. I have tested the water and it is not very consistant.

I dont have a problem with increasing to meet real upgrades. I do however have a problem with such a dramatic jump. It is not the communities fault that the Owner/Operator did not see this coming from 1999 'til 2005, May-be this was just bad management
