On May 13, 2008, Rocky Mountain Utility Company¹ filed an Application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity seeking authority to provide water service as a public utility near Rigby, Idaho. The Application states that the water system is currently providing water to 38 residential customers.

On June 20, 2008, the Commission issued a Notice of Application and set a deadline for intervention. Order No. 30576. No persons petitioned to intervene. A Notice of Public Workshop and Notice of Modified Procedure was issued on July 29, 2008. Order No. 30601. Several customers attended the workshop that was held on August 13, 2008, at the Rigby Senior Citizens Center.

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

YOU ARE HEREBY NOTIFIED that a public hearing has been scheduled for **TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 23, 2008, AT 7:00 P.M. AT THE JEFFERSON COUNTY COURTHOUSE, 210 COURTHOUSE WAY, RIGBY, IDAHO.** The purpose of the public hearing will be for the Commission to take the direct testimony of customers and interested members of the public. Testimony will be recorded and made part of the Commission's formal record for decision in this matter. The Company's customers and any other interested members of the public are encouraged to attend and give testimony.

YOU ARE FURTHER NOTIFIED that all hearings in this matter will be held in facilities meeting the accessibility requirements of the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA). Persons needing the help of a sign language interpreter or other assistance in order to participate in or to understand testimony and argument at a public hearing may ask the Commission to provide a sign language interpreter or other assistance at the hearing. The request for assistance



YOU ARE FURTHER NOTIFIED that the Commission has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to Title 61 of the Idaho Code and specifically *Idaho Code* §§ 61-124, 61-125, 61-129, 61-526, 61-528 and 61-623. The Commission may enter any final Order consistent with its authority under Title 61.

YOU ARE FURTHER NOTIFIED that all proceedings in this matter will be conducted pursuant to the Commission's Rules of Procedure, IDAPA 31.01.01.000 *et seq.*
