Community Action Partnership Association of Idaho and Citizens Allied for Integrity and Accountability petitioned to intervene in this case on December 28, 2018. All petitions were made pursuant to Rules of Procedure 71 through 75 of the Idaho Public Utilities Commission, IDAPA 31.01.01.071-.075.

FINDINGS OF FACT

We find that no party timely opposed these Petitions to Intervene.

We further find that based on the pleadings and other documents filed in this case, intervention by these parties would serve the purposes of intervention as described by Rule 74 of the Rules of Procedure and should be granted. If it appears that an intervenor does not have a direct or substantial interest in the proceeding, or that the intervention is not in the public interest, the Commission may set conditions on such intervention, or dismiss the intervenor from the proceeding. *See* Rules 13 and 74.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Petition to Intervene filed by Citizens Allied for Integrity and Accountability is hereby granted.
