
COMES NOW Teton Springs Water and Sewer Company LLC (“Teton Springs”) and the Staff of the Idaho Public Utilities Commission (“Staff”) and stipulate and agree that the Commission may enter its Order Clarifying Order No. 30718 as follows, to wit:

1. Order No. 30718 established rates that may be charged by Teton Springs to its retail customers as set forth in Schedule D attached to the Order.
2. In the opinion of Teton Springs, Schedule D creates an ambiguity as to the rate to be charged to individual dwelling units located within multiple family dwelling structures.
3. Both the Staff and Teton Springs believe the applicable rate for such customers is the rate for 1” residential service.
4. There are no other parties to case who would need to be consulted regarding this Stipulation.

WHEREFORE the Parties respectfully request that the Commission enter its order clarifying Order No. 30718 as set forth above.
