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On May 20, 2008, Teton Springs Water and Sewer Company, LLC (Teton Springs; Company) filed an Application with the Idaho Public Utilities Commission (Commission) requesting that the Commission issue it a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity. *Idaho Code* § 61-526; IDAPA 31.01.01.111. The Company also requested that the Commission approve a change in existing rates and charges for water service and approve the Company’s proposed Rules and Regulations Governing the Rendering of Water Service.

On June 12, 2008, the Commission in Order No. 30571 issued Certificate of Convenience and Necessity No. 475 to Teton Springs, authorized continued water service under the existing flat rate, and suspended the remainder of the Company’s Application. Accompanying the Commission’s Order was a Notice of Application.


