**I want to go on record against the 21.46 percent rate increase requested by United Water Idaho. Their rates are already too high. Any additional facilities and upgrades should be financed by the area's developers, not long time residents. Present rates should be grand fathered in for us.**

**My husband and I bought a home on 1/2 acre in 1975. We are presently both retired and therefore on limited income and subject to increasingly significant annual medical expenses among rising costs of living in this area. We are already being thrashed by the 25% summer water penalty. In response to that we have xerescaped as much of our property as possible. If we cut down any more, our thirty year old trees will die as many in our subdivision are doing.**
