The area of development currently is not within the certificated area of any water company. In order for United Water to provide service to the area, it must extend its facilities, including approximately 30,500 feet of main water line, a booster station, and a 600,000-gallon water storage reservoir. Avimor has agreed to provide the initial funding for the needed facilities at an approximate cost of \$6.3 million. United Water will provide refunds to Avimor as new customers are connected to the facilities. United Water requests that its Application be processed by Modified Procedure.

YOU ARE FURTHER NOTIFIED that the Commission has determined that the public interest may not require a formal hearing in this matter and will proceed under Modified Procedure pursuant to Rules 201 through 204 of the Idaho Public Utilities Commission's Rules of Procedure, IDAPA 31.01.01.201-204. The Commission notes that Modified Procedure and written comments have proven to be an effective means for obtaining public input and participation.

YOU ARE FURTHER NOTIFIED that the deadline for filing written comments or protests with respect to United Water's Application and the use of Modified Procedure in Case No. UWI-W-07-01 is 30 days from the service date of this Order. The Company deadline for filing reply comments is 15 days from the filing of Staff comments.
