My comment is on the Notice of Application to Increase Rates filed by United Water Idaho. I am working full-time and have not received even a penny's worth of increased pay now for four years even though the cost of living has gone up, including the price of gas, cost of food, etc. The request for another \$5.82 per month increase in rates is unnecessary and unwarranted.
